







Comments

- 1. Start with a square, white face up. Make a fish-base.
- 2. Pull down the back flap.
- 3. Precrease the top at angle bisector. Valley fold the bottom at perpendicular.
- 4. Valley fold down at angle bisector.
- 5. Repeat steps 3 to 5 on the other side.
- 6. This is how the precreases should look like.
- 7. Raise and open the front flap using existing creases.
- 8. Rabbit ear the front flap down. Pay attention to indicated mountain and valley folds.
- 9. Valley fold up. The center flap will go to the left.
- 10. Valley fold down.
- 11. Sqash fold the white flap which appeared in the process.
- 12. Petal fold the white flap.
- 13. Raise up the back flap.
- 14. Valley fold one layer to the left.
- 15. Valley fold down. You will have to release some trapped paper.
- 16. Squash fold one layer.
- 17. Petal fold to the left.
- 18. Valley fold two white flaps to the left.
- 19. Repeat steps 16 to 18 on the right.
- 20. Valley fold one white flap to the right.
- 21. Valley fold one coloured flap on each side, at perpendicular. This will form the arms.
- 22. Fold and unfold so that corners meet in the middle. Note where the creases intercept the arms.
- 23. Valley fold down at the top of the white flap.
- 24. Valley fold up. The crease meets the indicated points at step 23.
- 25. Turn over.

- 26. Spread squash the center flap.
- 27. Wrap around one layer (this is like removing a closed sink).
- 28. Valley fold both sides toward the center, using creases made at step 23.
- 29. Swivel on both sides.
- 30. Tuck the front flap inside the pocket behind, on both sides.
- 31. Tuck both side corners behind the triangular assembly in the center.
- 32. Mountain fold the top of the triangle inside the model. This should lock the sides of the model.
- 33. Precrease where indicated. Turn over.
- 34. Valley fold down. Precrease upward (1/2).
- 35. Precrease upward (1/4).
- 36. Unfold back to step 36.
- 37. Wrap arround the top of the triangle at existing crease.
- 38. Valley fold on both sides.
- 39. Valley fold down using existing crease.
- 40. Valley fold up (see next step for positioning).
- 41. Precrease at perpendicular.
- 42. Fold the model in half (mountain fold), add a reverse fold using creases made at step 43.
- 43. Inside reverse fold the feet. Do not hesitate to make big feet, so that the model can stand. Shape the arms.
- 44. Round both legs, rotate the feet to the sides. Round the whole body.
- 45. More shaping is needed so that the penguin looks cute. The penguin is completed.
